Important Notes

- **All ultrasounds MUST be fasted for 8 hours. A small amount of water is okay.**
- The ultrasound site will be shaved and ultrasound gel will be applied. Some residue may remain when the patient is sent home.
- A full bladder is needed for bladder/kidney ultrasounds. It may be difficult for the pet to hold their bladder and they may be required to stay for the day to allow the bladder to fill.
- **Please prescribe Gabapentin at 20-25 mg/kg , PO, the night before and 3 hours before the appointment.**
- Injectable sedation may be necessary to complete the ultrasound. Additional charges will apply and the pet will need to stay to be monitored after sedation.
- Ultrasounds typically take 30 to 60 minutes and owners are asked to wait for their pet. If the pet needs to stay for sedation or to let their bladder fill, a discharge time will be arranged.
- Upon completion of the ultrasound, Dr. Grant will write a report and forward it to the attending Veterinary for review. Dr. Grant will not be discussing results with the client.
